

New law changes required for vaccines available to children Health officials in the Blackfoot have made a law change so that the state of Utah and the specific schools where children go to are able to give vaccines to those children. The law change was made in an effort to ensure that parents have the right to know that vaccines are given to their children and that the state has a duty to give the vaccines. The law change also changed that in the future, the vaccine is required to be given to those children in the age group of 4 months to 6 years and 15 months. This is different from previous laws that required vaccines to be given to the children in the age group of 2 to 18 years. Previously, there was a law that required vaccinations to be given only to those in the age group of 2 to 18 years of age. In those cases, only an insurance company or an emergency room would have been able to administer the vaccines and not the public schools. According to Health Department Spokesperson Stephanie Clayton, the law change was made in an effort to protect the children in the Blackfoot school district from vaccinations. "We're just at the end of this process," Clayton said. Clayton went on to state that according to the Utah Code, the school cannot exclude any students from school. She also stated that according to Utah law, all children in a school district must be vaccinated and that the vaccine can be given at school. "The requirement for public school is that children must receive the vaccine," Clayton stated. Clayton went on to state that the law change was made in the hope that vaccine providers will change their forms to include the age group of children 4 months to 6 years and 15 months.
